**USSSA Pile on the Points Classic / Last Chance Classic  
June 26th / June 27th**

Dear Managers,

Team check-in is mandatory with tournament director (1 hour prior to your first game). **You MUST check-in prior to playing your first game.** We will need a copy of an updated 2010 season USSSA team roster/registration (No signatures needed) and copies of birth certificates or state issued ID cards for each player. Players do not need to be present at check-in. Teams not registered with USSSA for the 2010 season will need to do so online at [www.ussa.com](http://www.ussa.com). Teams will NOT be able to register at the tournament and all players added or deleted must be done online prior to check-in. **Players may NOT be penciled in on your rosters.** Players will not play if a birth certificate/ID card is not available for verification at check-in. Age cut off is **May 1st, 2010.** (e.g., 12U player can not turn 13 prior to May 1st, 2010). Players may play up, but not down in age.

Check the website daily for schedule revisions. Arizona USSSA Tournaments reserves the right to modify the brackets should scheduling conflicts arise. The bracket schedule displayed at check-in supersedes all other revisions. Recheck brackets online the night before tournament starts.

The Tournament hotline for **weather updates will be (480) 326-5399 or bracket page on the website.** Phone numbers for playoff seedings after pool play will be posted at your parks on the bracket board. Only 1 coach per team may call these numbers

Please have your team ready to play up to 15 minutes prior to the posted game time in case of a run rule in a prior game. This will help us to stay on schedule.

**Steel cleats may not be worn on portable mounds at any park. Make sure the pitchers have an extra pair of shoes to pitch in. The Umpires will strictly enforce this.**

**Big League Dreams Park** has a daily gate charge of \$3.00 for spectators 13 & older and coaches. Players participating will be charged \$1.00 gate fee. All charged patrons will receive a \$1.00 token for use at concessions. Spectators 12 & Under are admitted free of charge. Make sure to get a hand stamp for re-entry on the same day.

This park is a private facility that offers many amenities. Concessions will be available from Two Stadium Restaurants.

No outside food or drinks may be brought into the park except bottled water. No ice chests are allowed.

**Water will be provided in the dug outs in 10 gallon Jugs for players/coaches only. DO NOT Open the jugs to remove ice or soak rags due to sterilization health code violations.**

**No Hitting Stations will be allowed on the grass. Gates will open 1 hour prior to first game.**

**\*\*\*\*Frozen Rosters\*\*\*\*** We have already froze a percentage of the rosters in Arizona. Please note that the USSSA system will freeze the top 25% of teams in a division at each tournament. EXAMPLE if there are 8 in your division the system will freeze 2 spots. If 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> are already frozen it will go to the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place teams as long as they won 1 game in the tournament. **PLEASE CHECK YOUR ROSTERS BEFORE COMING TO THE TOURNAMENT.**

Team Awards (Voucher) for 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> & Individual Awards for 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> will be given out in each age group for AAA, AA and Open Divisions. Additionally, the top Team in each division also qualifies for a USSSA World Series Berth.

Teams will be directed to a designated awards presentation area.

It is your team's responsibility to claim their awards at the tournament. Awards will not be mailed unless the team pays for shipping and handling fees in advance.

Finally, we would like to thank the players, parents and coaches for choosing to play in this tournament. We realize there are many tournaments from which to choose. We want to make this tournament an enjoyable experience for everyone, especially the players. Please feel free to call upon the tournament staff or us to service you in any way.
